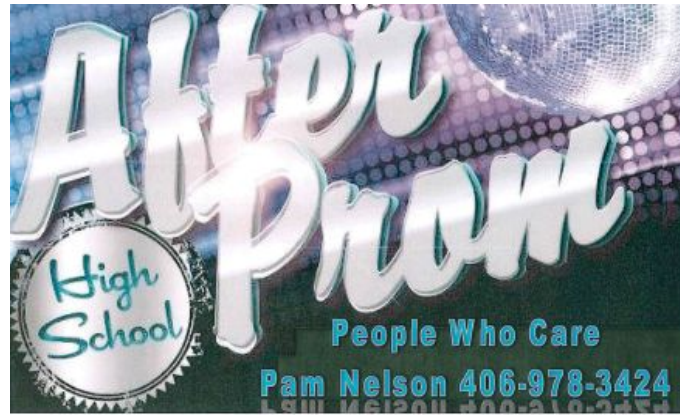
**Teachers: 3rd Quarter grades are due to the office NO later than Mon. Mar. 19th at 8am.**
