Children who screened last year and were not flagged for re-screening do not need to attend

Children aged 3—5 years will be screened in the following areas: Concepts/Thinking Skills, Motor Skills, Speech/Language development, Vision, Hearing

Children under 3 years will be screened by DEAP staff using the DENVER, as well as for Hearing
