Here is some information about upcoming events/deadlines as you prepare for graduation!!!

A. Class Colors: Black with maroon and gold

Class Flower: Pink rose

Motto: "We didn't realize we were making memories, we just knew we were having fun."

B. Senior Pictures:

You/Your child will need to submit 2 COLORED/VERTICAL senior photos **NO LATER THAN MARCH 16TH**. One photo will be used for the annual and the Senior Hall Composite; the annual company that we use prefers that you (or your photographer) send Mrs. Bettenhausen a digital photo at the highest resolution possible. Mrs. Bettenhausen's email is bettenhausenc@baker.12.mt.us. The other photo will be used for the Fallon County Times and their email is fctimes@midriver.com.

C. Senior Booklets:

Leslie Bohle will be assembling the senior booklets once again this year. Each senior OR parent should submit ONE 8 ½ x 11 VERTICAL page for publication in this booklet that will be presented at the Parent-Senior Banquet. Here are the requirements:

1. Leslie WILL assemble/design the page for you for a \$25 fee; she asks that you send her all the photos/quotes/images that you would like to have on the page **NO LATER THAN MARCH 1ST**.
2. If you prefer to do the layout yourself, she needs to have it **NO LATER THAN MARCH 16TH**. You have two options:
 - a. Send her the page you have designed in EITHER a jpeg OR pdf format. Her email is: **leslie@bohleimages.com**
 - b. Give her a hard copy of the page you have designed and she can scan it for you and submit it. SHE WILL HAVE A BOX AT THE HIGH SCHOOL OFFICE WHERE THESE CAN BE DROPPED OFF.

IF YOU DO THE LAYOUT YOURSELF, here are some things to remember:

- a. Your margins ON ALL 4 SIDES must be at least ¼" from the edge, otherwise you run the risk of something being cut off.
- b. You may include as many photos as you want; PLEASE include a personal senior motto or quote IF YOU HAVE ONE.
- c. Make certain to proof the page **YOURSELF; Mrs. Bohle will not be responsible for any errors.**

D. SLIDESHOW:

Leslie Bohle has agreed to create the slideshow; here are the requirements:

- a. 3 photos of each student: baby OR infant; elementary; senior. Again, it would be best to submit these digitally to Leslie; she will take hard copies if you cannot do this digitally. The deadline for these photos is **MARCH 16TH**.
- b. Leslie needs to have the seniors submit 5-6 songs they would like to have included; remember, this is only a 3 minute presentation so she will do snippets of the songs.

- c. Any student OR parent who would like to have a copy of the slideshow is asked to give LESLIE a flash drive and she will put the slideshow on there for you. SHE WILL HAVE A BOX AT THE HIGH SCHOOL OFFICE WHERE THESE CAN BE DROPPED OFF ; MAKE CERTAIN YOUR NAME IS ON THE FLASHDRIVE SOMEWHERE

E. SENIOR SUPPLEMENT:

The following information must be submitted on or before April 1 and it will be presented at the Parent-Senior banquet in a separate packet from the senior booklet; it is too expensive to include these pages in the senior booklet that Leslie Bohle will be doing. Please submit the following information, TYPED, TIMES ROMAN 12. You do not have to supply an answer for all of these; you may do as many or as few as you want. Double check for errors!

1. Your full name
2. Your personal motto or quote or saying
3. A list of activities during your high school career; include all clubs, activities, extracurricular and include any offices/honors you may have received.
4. What are your future plans? Where do you intend to work OR attend college AND your intended major.
5. Your personal "will"; begin with "I will..." then follow that with a list of things or positions you had while at BHS that you are "gifting" or "leaving" to students who remain behind.
6. Your personal prophecy: Where do you think you will be/what will you be doing IN TEN YEARS?
7. Your best advice to underclassmen?
8. Lessons you have learned that have taught you the most.
9. Things you wish you would have done AND/OR not done in high school.
10. What is the most surprising thing to you about high school?
